The Forum for African Women Educationist (FAWE Ghana Chapter) was formed in 1993 as part of an African regional organization with its headquarters in Nairobi, Kenya. FAWE works to promote the education of girls, the empowerment of women and to correct gender disparities in education all over sub-Saharan Africa. FAWE Ghana has a membership of sixty organizations and individuals including: female Ministers of Education, prominent educationists, as well as professional and women's groups at the community level. Today it is one of the leading NGOs promoting girls' education and women's empowerment in Ghana. FAWE believes that through the education of women and girls, livelihoods are improved for entire communities and civic education and liberties are enhanced. Educated girls become educated women who have the knowledge, skills and opportunities to play a role in governance and democratic processes and to influence the direction of their societies. The Ghana chapter has developed four key assets, namely; (i) An Information and Documentation Centre; (ii) Leadership Training Centre; (iii) Girls' Senior High School and (iv) FM Radio Station. FAWE Ghana has a network of partners in twenty – seven districts known as Focal Point Contact

FAWE Ghana is committed to utilizing diverse strategies that are suited to improving education for girls in Ghana. This means implementing a broad range of innovative programmes, such as a Girls Senior High School that has been designated a Centre of Excellence, community based monitoring systems, Girls' Clubs in schools and communities, libraries and resource centres, a Leadership Training Centre; scholarships and awards; adolescent sexual reproductive health and HIV & AIDS training and a radio station. FAWE is in need of a volunteer to support them in monitoring and evaluation as well as fundraising.
